It is an opportunity to express God's love through Christ by welcoming everyone, and helps set the tone of the upcoming worship service; encouraging visitors to want to come back. The heart of hospitality is the heart of a servant.

QUALIFICATIONS

Visitors won't always remember everything you said, but they will remember how you made them feel. The Hospitality ministry is the first opportunity to make an impression for the positive experience we want visitors to have.

HOW WE SERVE

Help spread the love of Christ by doing simple things for visitors and the body of Christ. Various serving opportunities are available:

GREETERS & FIRST TIME CHECK-IN:

- ~A smile can change a person's day and make them feel connected.
- ~Looking at people in the eyes shows kindness. It says to them, "You Count."
- ~When someone is struggling with

heavy items or they have their hands full, offer to help them.

~When someone looks lost, ask them, "How can I help you?"

~Say hello. In today's busy world it's easy to become isolated from others, oblivious to the pain and concerns of the people around us. Acknowledge them. People remember kindness.

~Make a difference by going above and beyond normal expectations. Help church visitors experience something different. Introduce yourself to someone new and make them feel like they belong.

USHERS:

~ Generally Calvary's Usher Team is in need of usher's help, 20 minutes before the start of any Sunday service.

~ During that 20 minute period, ushers can assist with the above listed support and also help interact with Calvary's parishioners.

~ Coupled with the 20 minute period, is the collection of the offering, which takes 5 minutes and is taken before the church announcements.

~ After the offering, ushers are encouraged to sit down and listen to the word of God. However if an usher wants to assist during the service, they are welcome to attend another service.
